

For King and Empire v1.0



‘For King and Empire’ is a British World War 2 campaign set during the years 1940 to 1945 for the Adlerkorps E-File. It covers battles in East Africa, North Africa, Italy, France, Belgium, Holland and Germany. It takes the less well-travelled path of the British war effort to begin with and then brings in some big battles like Caen and Market Garden as the war progresses.

My reason for making the campaign is relatively simple: I don’t feel there are enough (quality) campaigns for the United Kingdom, and I wanted to rectify that. It also covers a few battles and campaigns that have been given scant coverage – both in real life and PG2, and that was also a major motivating factor for me.

I hope you enjoy it as much as I enjoyed creating it. A lot of work has gone into it, especially to make each scenario historically accurate – something I seem to be obsessed with.

Installing the Campaign

This campaign is designed for the latest version of PG2 that can be downloaded from the ‘Adlerkorps’ website at: <http://www.adlerkorps.com/> or alternatively ‘Steve’s PG2’ at: <http://hosted.wargamer.com/pg2campaigns/steve/pg2.htm>

To install, unzip the contents of ‘campaign-files’ into your ‘SCENARIO’ folder. After starting up PG2 you should hopefully see ‘For King and Empire’ listed in the campaign menu.
